PROCESSING

Instructions for use

- Put a sufficiently large amount of the product in the palm of your hand (approx. 3 ml).
- Ensure complete wetting of the hands during the recommended exposure time of 30 sec.
- Rub on both hands up to the root of the hand. Also wet the back of the hand and the spaces between the fingers. For sufficient effectiveness, two consecutive applications should be made. The hands or other objects must not be touched during the application period to ensure unrestricted effectiveness.
- Do not use on premature and newborn babies. Not suitable for disinfecting mucous membranes. Do not use in the immediate vicinity of the eyes or open wounds.
- The product is ready to use.

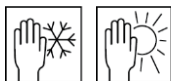

At least 2 years in the original sealed containers.

Regarding the durability after opening, in not re-sealed containers, a period of 6 months applies.
